Journeying Together in St Ninian's: Synod on Synodality 4-29 October, 2023.

Bishop Brian McGee of the Diocese of Argyll and the Isles will represent Scotland at the Synod in Rome. To assist him, each Synod Core Group in Scotland was asked to reflect, discuss, discern and respond to an issue for discussion at the synod. We were asked to consider: Co-responsibility in Mission: How can we better share gifts and tasks in the service of the Gospel? Two of the issues we stressed in our submission were:

1. 'the importance of inspiring all the faithful to appreciate the many and varied skills they possess and to exercise the same for the salvation of their souls and the greater good of the Church.'

2. 'Since every baptised person is clothed, without distinction, in Christ, women must be given an equal voice and equal dignity.' *M Ruddy*
