On 4th October, Pope Francis published Laudato Deum, a "part two" of his 2015 encyclical, Laudato Si which focusses on our climate crisis. In it he tells us that "Our responses have not been adequate, while the world in which we live is collapsing and may be nearing breaking point. (LD 2) In this exhortation the Pope calls on all of us to make changes.

"A broad change in the irresponsible lifestyle connected with the Western model would have a significant long-term impact." (LD 72).
