The First Session of the Synod in Rome is over. The Second Session will be held in October 2024. The Bishop of Argyle and the Isles, Brian McGee, was the Scottish representative at the synod. He found the assembly an incredible experience and assures us that, if the Church journeys along the synodal path and remains open to the Holy Spirit all will be well for the future of the Church. With regard to the synod report he wrote:

' It is important to recognise that the text doesn't have definitive answers precisely because we have one more year for prayer, sharing and deeper discernment. However, next October's Synod will present concrete proposals to the Pope for his consideration.'
