The Big Plastic Count Results.... It's been just over a month since parishioners took part in the biggest investigation into household plastic. The results are in and sadly the UK tops the charts for plastic waste per person globally, second only to the US.

As part of the **UK Plastics Pact** supermarkets promised to make all their plastic packaging reusable, recyclable or compostable by 2025. The results prove they are nowhere near that goal. We are throwing away an estimated **1.7 billion** pieces of plastic a week- that's **90 BILLION** per year! You might be shocked to learn that very little of that waste gets recycled, while over half of it is being incinerated here in the UK, polluting the air we breathe with toxic gases and damaging our Common Home.
