Journeying Together: Mgr Ald8 Goes to Rome

On February 3rd 2024, the Synod Secretariat announced that Pope Francis has invited 300 Parish Priests from around the world to come to Rome to take part in a 4 day Meeting in preparation for the final session of the Synod on Synodality. Our own Mgr Aldo will represent the Catholics of Scotland at this event. He asks for our prayers as he heads for the Fraternal Retreat Centre 25 km north of Rome where he will be actively involved in 'Conversations in the Spirit' at round tables and where parish priests from around the world will share best practices, take part in workshops around pastoral proposals, engage in liturgical celebrations and dialogue with experts.
