The Jubilee Year 2025. Pilgrims of Hope

Pope Francis officially launched the 2025 Jubilee Year with the solemn opening of the Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica on Christmas Eve, and the three other Major Basilicas in Rome. He is calling all pilgrims of hope from every country and language to walk in the holiness of life. For the first time in the Jubilee tradition, Pope Francis opened a fifth holy door in Rebibbia prison on 26 December, "inviting all prisoners to look to the future with hope and a renewed sense of confidence." He prayed, "may the light of Christian hope illumine every man and woman, as a message of God's love addressed to all!
