(17 December 1936 - 21 April 2025):
Pope Francis, the 266th pontiff of the Roman
Catholic Church, has died at the age of 88.
The Vatican announced Francis died at 7:35 a.m.
on Monday, one day after Easter, due to a cerebral stroke leading to a coma and irreversible heart failure. RIP.
