Some felt a bit anxious and unsure at the start but in the end, everyone agreed they had found the experience spiritually uplifting. **Our second conversation will take place this coming Tuesday 3 June at 7pm in St Ninian's Church Hall.** The question for discussion is: **What word or phrase stands out for you in the following quote and what possibilities does it open up for our diocese?** 'Synodality involves gathering at all levels of the Church for mutual listening, dialogue, and communal discernment. It also involves reaching consensus as an expression of Christ rendering Himself present, He who is alive in the Spirit.
