Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost (69) of the United States has been elected the 267th Pope. The new leader of the worlds 1.4 billion Catholics will be known as Pope Leo X1V. He spent much of his career as a missionary in South America and most recently led a powerful Vatican office for Bishop appointments. He is expected to build on Pope Francis reforms. Pope Leo is a member of the Augustinian religious order of which he went on to lead as global superior and spent many years working in Peru. He was later Bishop of Chicalayo, Peru, before being chosen by Francis to lead the Vatican's Bishop office. We thank God for our new Pope and pray for him as he takes on this monumental responsibility. Deo Gratis Alleluia.
